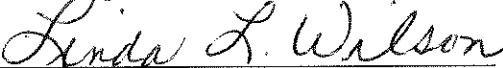
The Board met in Executive Session: I. C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)

Dr. Brian Allred, Assistant Superintendent gave an update ILearn and IRead 3 Re-Test. He mentioned that the window for ILearn testing is now over. He mentioned the re-test for IRead 3 is May 20 and our teachers are in full remediation for IRead. Dr. Allred updated the Board on summer school, we have 6 teachers and CES, 4 at CMS and a 1-week algebra bridge for 8th grade students as well as 2 teachers at CHS, along with our credit recovery program. Dr. Allred updated the Board on Camp Invention and how we have about 40 students for that this year and gave Ashley Pavlina a shout out for her hard work and that she has really hit the ground running on this.

Comments:

Comments from CEA: Ms. Sally Wade congratulated all the building winners for Teacher of the Year, especially Tosha Embry. Sally went on to inform the Board members that some of the ISTA members will be attending the SBOE tomorrow, May 8 to push back and ask for clarity on the Literacy endorsement and wider options for professional development. They are concerned that teachers who have already completed extensive training, over \$5000 paid for by the Corporation that won't count towards this literacy endorsement. This is going to have an impact on teachers and their license. Another problem is getting registered, the website is having issues and causing delays in the registration process. The high school diploma is another issue they are concerned about. They are worried about the flexibility and this new diploma track is taking away from the Core 40, and they feel like this is pushing kids to specialize in jobs/careers too early. She will continue to keep the Board updated on what happens at this meeting.

There were no Citizen comments at this meeting.

Comments from Board Members: Mr. Wilson said that he was happy to be here; Ms. Davis-Craig said that she was happy Bill was here. She also mentioned that she knows this time of year is stressful and there is a lot going on but she is very proud of our staff and they do an amazing job with a smile on their face. 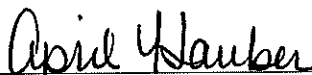
