Clarksville Education Association Scholarship. Students must be planning to enter the field of education.
Clarksville Optimist Club. Friend of Youth scholarship. All college-bound graduates are eligible to apply.
Clarksville Middle School PTO Scholarship. Student must have attended CMS all 3 years.
Clarksville Elementary PTO Scholarship. Students must have attended CES, CMS, and CHS.
Eva Jo Franz Athletic Scholarship / Kathryn Chaney Scholarship. Recipients must be two-sport athletes with the highest GPA and have financial need. If recipient receives a full scholarship, the award will go to the next student-athlete who qualifies and has financial need. Scholarships will be awarded to one male and one female student. Must submit first semester university grades by March 1 to receive scholarship funds.**
James Todd Swearingen Memorial Scholarship. Must have an unweighted GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must be accepted into and attend an accredited two- or four-year public or private college or university. First preference will be given to those who have demonstrated emphasis in the study of any foreign language during their high school years, preferably German. Second preference given to those pursuing post-secondary academic study in the field of a foreign language.
John and Candy Barksdale Social Work Scholarship. Must have an unweighted GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, seeking to support the "average" student. Must be accepted into and attend an accredited two or four year public or private college or university and pursuing a post-secondary academic study in social work. Preference will be given to students with demonstrated financial need. 21 st Century Scholars are not eligible for an award. (1 st Offered 20-21 school year, offered odd graduation years only)
Mr. B's Memorial Scholarship. Must have an unweighted GPA of 2.0 on 4.0 scale. Must be accepted into and attend an accredited two- or four-year public or private college or university. First preference will be given to those who have demonstrated emphasis in the study of theatre and/or fine arts during their high school years. Second preference given to those pursuing post-secondary academic study in the field of theatre and/or fine arts.
Kelly Bryant Memorial Athletic Scholarship. Must have GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale and a letter of acceptance to an accredited college or university. Must have participated in high school sports for at least three years, with one year being graduating year. Include a 250 words or less short essay, stating: "The Impact high school sports has had on my life."*
Alumni Association Scholarship. Student must plan to further education and have a need for financial assistance. Must have a GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale. Must have demonstrated leadership and participation throughout his/her years at CHS.**
Alan K. Wilson Football Memorial Scholarship. Must have a GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must have played football for a minimum of three years. Include a 200 words or less short essay, stating: "What football/being part of a team has meant to me."*
Rebecca DeWees Memorial Scholarship. Student must be an office assistant and plan to be attending college or additional vocational training.
